### TRIPLE PENANCE FOR TRIPLE CONCUPISCENCE

On this first Sunday of Lent, we hear the Genesis account of the Fall of Adam and Eve. The ancient Jews recognised three root causes of sin revealed in this story which they refer to as **Triple Concupiscence** (concupiscence is the "inclination to sin.").

It is this sinful condition that has infected the whole human race and is what everyone wrestles with daily. St John the Apostle warns us about Triple Concupiscence in his first epistle. He says: "*Do not love the world or the things in the world. The love of the Father is not in those who love the world; for all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.*" (1 John 2:15–17)

**The lust of the flesh** is an inordinate or unnatural desire for bodily pleasure of any kind such as food, drink, sensual pleasures, excessive comforts, etc. **the lust of the eyes** is an inordinate or unnatural desire for possessions. This can manifest itself in greed, envy, consumerism, materialism, etc. Finally, **the pride of life** is a rebellion and disobedience against God seen in sins such as egotism, pride, selfishness, arrogance, atheism, etc. All sin can be categorised into one of these three divisions. To overcome these sinful temptations Jesus gives us the remedy of **Triple Penance**, which refers to the three traditional penitential acts that he speaks about in his famous Sermon on the Mount, namely: **Fasting**, to overcome the *lust of the flesh*; **Almsgiving**, to overcome the *lust of the eyes*; **Prayer**, to overcome the *pride of life*. (cf. Matthew 6:1-18)
