Our Churches Together Around Tadley (CTAT) Unity Service in Saint Michael's Church last Sunday, following the fine one at Mortimer Methodist Church of the Sunday before, went exceptionally well. In spite of the inclement weather, around 50 people attended from our local Christian communities, and there was a real "buzz" during the reception afterwards. Our thanks to Mary Lee and her group of volunteers who presented a fine selection of cakes and biscuits alongside tea and coffee. The Collection for the work of Sam Dunn, our CTAT Youth Worker in our local schools, came to £153.00. The Service addressed the development of the Pray Tadley initiative, beyond our Advent concern to pray for hope, peace, love and joy within Tadley and surrounding areas, for all people to feel God's presence, whatever their situation.

This initiative is to continue into 2025 and beyond, recognising that so many around us are sometimes struggling in various ways, including our youngsters. There are cards in Saint Michael's Church porch enabling you to join me in this prayer, sending prayer requests for yourself or others who have asked you to do so, having received their permission first.

Many thanks to Peter Hughes for the photographs in the newsletter, which were published in our Diocesan e-news alongside a good report from him also. I believe the Rev. Karen West is contacting the Anglican Diocese of Winchester for a similar report. Sadly, our Salvation Army Moderator, Stuart Madden, was unable to attend because of a bad throat.
